



EASTER ONE-SHEET TREAT BAG

- 1** Stamp Bunny Kitty with black ink on white cardstock. Punch out image using scallop square punch. Color with prisma-color markers. Brush edges of scallop square with orange ink pad. Attach scallop square to lime green cardstock. Set aside.
- 2** Ink carrot using orange and green markers and stamp on white cardstock. Repeat and trim out carrots. Set aside.

You'll need:

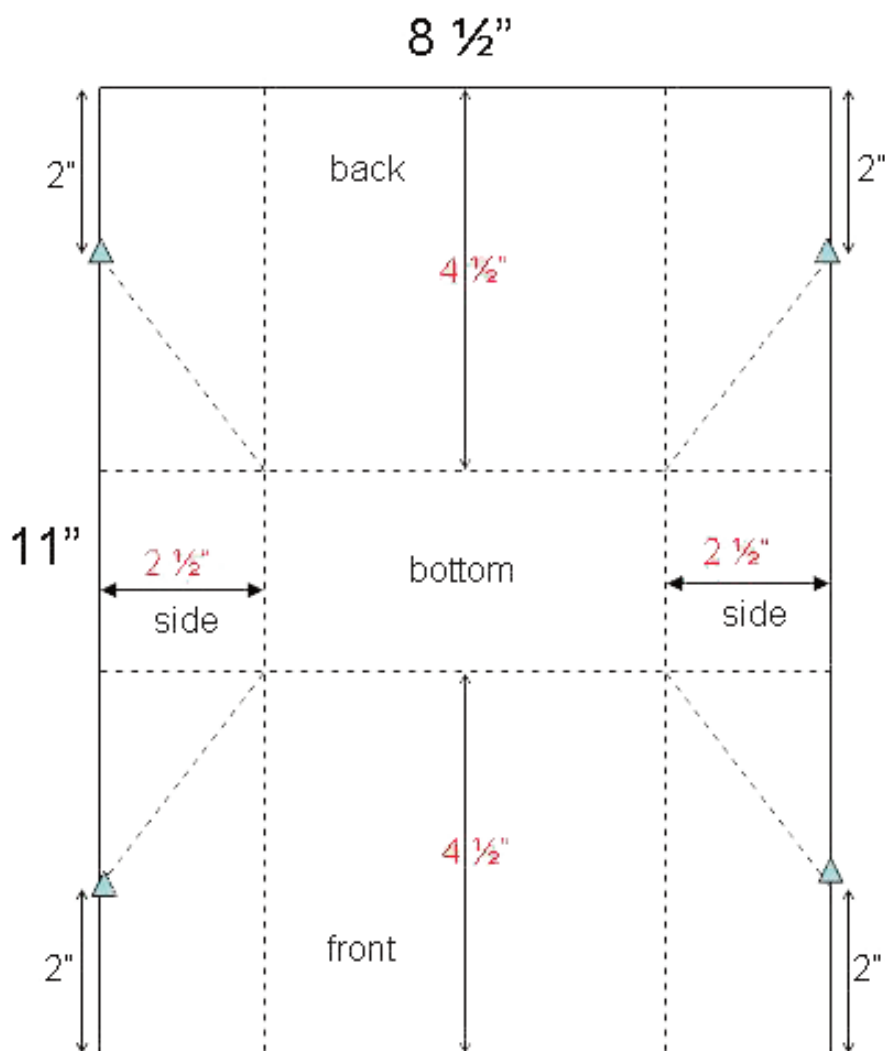
- Bunny Kitty (E-4204)
 - Carrot (B-5316)
- 8 1/2" x 11" orange cardstock
- 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" of green cardstock
- 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" lime green cardstock
 - White card stock
- Marvy giga scallop square punch
- Large scallop scissors or corner punch
 - 1/8" hole punch
- Marvy ink pens (orange/green)
 - Versafine ink (onyx black)
- Colorbox chalk ink (tangerine)
 - Prismacolor Markers
 - Ribbons
 - Sushi grass

One-Sheet Treat Box

- 3** Lengthwise, measure 2 1/2" from the right edge of the orange cardstock and score. Repeat for left edge.
- 4** Measure and score cardstock widthwise 4 1/2" from top and bottom.
- 5** Mark paper 2" from the top and bottom on both sides of the cardstock.
- 6** Score cardstock diagonally to the 2" mark as shown on diagram. Rotate paper and repeat three more times.
- 7** Fold vertical and horizontal score marks over. Then fold diagonal score marks in. (*Diagonal folds will want to naturally fold inwards towards the center of the box.*)

Finishing Touches

- 8** Fold primary green cardstock piece in half lengthwise. Cut lengthwise along one edge with large scallop scissors (or use corner punch repeatedly). Punch 1/8" holes through each scallop.
- 9** Place piece over top of the box and attach it to the back side of the box.
- 10** Punch two 1/8" holes through both the topper and the bag and thread ribbons through.
- 11** Attach scallop square piece and carrots to front of box as shown. Attach sushi grass to front of box as shown.
