



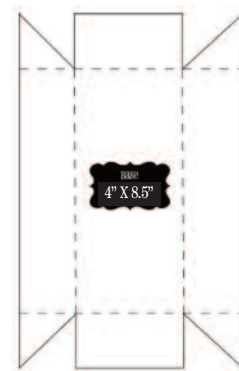
# TRICKITY TREATS CONTAINER

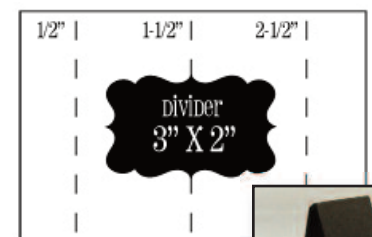
## Box Base

**1** Score the 4" x 8.5" Black Cardstock at 1" from each of the four sides.

**2** Trim away small triangle from each corner to form tabs as shown in diagram. Create all score lines. Fold small tabs up and inward to form base of treat container. Adhere end tabs with redline tape.



**3** Create three divider pieces from three 3" x 2" pieces of black cardstock. Score each piece at 1/2", 1-1/2", and 2-1/2" from the short side as shown below.



**4** Crease all score lines and fold so that middle score line comes up in a mountain fold. The two side score lines will fold outwards to lay flat against the bottom of the container.

**5** Position dividers to fit the candy that you choose to place inside the box. *You'll need to do this planning before you cut the windows in your patterned paper piece for the candy to show through.*

- NIGHTIE ALPHABET Clearly Swanky Stamp Set (S-8636 CL)
- BABYDOLL ALPHABET Clearly Swanky Stamp Set (W-9673 CL)
- Black Cardstock —
  - 1 @ 4" x 8.5"
  - 3 @ 3" x 2"
  - 1 @ approx. 1-1/8" x 6-1/2"
- Patterned Paper —
  - 1 @ 3" x 6.5" heavyweight
  - 1 @ approx. 1" x 6-1/2"
- Lime Green Cardstock —
  - 2 @ 1" x 6.5"
  - 1 @ 3-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- Clear Heavyweight Acetate Sheet — 7" x 6.5"
- White Cardstock — 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" and scraps for tag
- Opaque White Stazon Ink
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink
- Orange, Green, and Purple dye inks

## TRICKITY TREATS CONTAINER

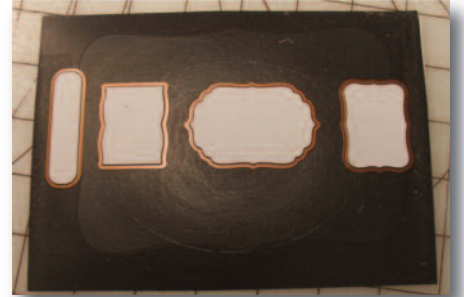
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### Patterned Paper Peek-A-Boo Window Piece

- 1 Score and crease 3" x 6.5" piece of heavyweight patterned paper at 1/2" from each of the long sides. Choose various Nestabilities dies or punches to create windows for each candy treat to show through. I used the following Nestabilities dies:

Labels Trio - smallest die  
Labels Seven - 2nd smallest die  
Labels Four - 3rd smallest die  
Labels Eight - smallest die

- 2 Lay your patterned paper and your container base with candy and dividers next to the dies on the magnetic Wizard mat to position your dies. You'll need to "eyeball" where each die will need to be so that it is centered in each candy section. Carefully place the 2" center portion of your patterned paper over the dies and cut your windows.



- 3 Use the Martha Stewart Goo Border punch and lime green cardstock strips to create two "goeey" border strips. Adhere one to each long side of your "peek-a-boo" window patterned paper piece. {Lay this piece over top of your treat box base to position the "goo" strips so that they don't extend beyond the bottom of your box.}

### Acetate Sleeve

- 1 Score 7" x 6.5" piece of heavyweight acetate cardstock at 1-1/2", 2-1/2", 4-1/2", and 5-1/2" from the shorter side. Crease all score lines and flatten sheet. Stamp "Boo!" using Opaque White Stazon ink randomly all over acetate. Let dry thoroughly. Wrap acetate sheet around box base with candy and patterned paper layer. Secure at the back with redline double stick tape.

### Tag

- 1 Stamp witch from FRIGHT NIGHT set using Tuxedo Black Memento ink onto white cardstock. Color and cut out.
- 2 Stamp "Trickity" onto white cardstock using NIGHTIE ALPHABET and black ink and cut out.
- 3 Cut tag shape from white and lime green cardstock using 3rd largest Nestabilities Labels Eight die. Stamp "TREATS" onto lower portion of white cardstock die shape using black, orange, green, and purple inks. Use grey marker to add drop shadow to each letter. Cut top 1" from white cardstock die cut shape and layer to green die cut.
- 4 Trim ends of patterned paper strip in "V" shape and layer to black cardstock strip. Cut ends of black cardstock into "V" shape to create banner. Adhere banner to die cut tag with foam tape. Tie twine bow to large button. Adhere button, "Trickity", and little witch to center of banner strip. Punch small hole in upper left corner of tag and tie to treat container with ribbon bow.
